# SUMMARY OF KEY FINDINGS

- **1.** In your opinion, how important is it to reduce the number of people who are in prison in America today?
  - 73% TOTAL IMPORTANT

## 20% TOTAL NOT IMPORTANT

- 42% Very important
- 31% Somewhat important
- 12% Not very important
- 8% Not at all important
- 7% Don't Know/Refused
- 2. Thinking ahead to the midterm elections this November how important to you is the issue of criminal justice reform as you decide who you'll be voting for?

## 82% TOTAL IMPORTANT

- 14% TOTAL NOT IMPORTANT
- 49% Very important
- 33% Somewhat important
- 9% Not very important
- 5% Not at all important
- 4% Don't know



**3.** As you may know, the US House of Representatives recently passed the FIRST STEP Act by a large bipartisan majority. The FIRST STEP Act is a criminal justice reform bill that helps federal inmates transition to life after prison and allows for reduced prison time for well-behaved and older inmates.

In your opinion, how important is it that the US Senate – which is controlled by a Republican majority – pass the FIRST STEP Act before the November midterm elections?
