## Dear Senator:

On behalf of more than 160,000 Americans for Prosperity-Florida activists, I urge you to oppose S.B. 526, an act relating to The Entertainment Industry, when it is voted on tomorrow in the Commerce and Tourism Committee. This vote will be recorded in our 2019 session legislative scorecard.

S.B. 526 allows for up to \$2 million per qualified film project to be given out by the state to a movie, television, or digital game businesses. This is corporate welfare that fails the state's fiscal responsibility to taxpayers. Instead of handouts to companies, government should offer pro-market solutions for economic growth such as removing unnecessary regulations and fees that can hinder a firms' ability to operate.

AFP-FL and our activists believe strongly in opposing governments using tax dollars as handouts for corporate welfare. It is for this reason that I ask for your opposition of S.B. 526.
