Dear Senator:

On behalf of more than 160,000 Americans for Prosperity-Florida activists, I urge you to support S.B. 642 an act relating to Criminal Justice, when it is voted on tomorrow in the Appropriations Subcommittee on Criminal and Civil Justice. This vote will be recorded in our 2019 session legislative scorecard.

S.B. 642, sponsored by Senator Brandes, will make a number of reforms to the criminal justice system including placing inmates closer to their primary residence for better access to family, improving programs for reentry into society, and increasing educational resources for inmates. These reforms are designed to help an inmate work through their sentencing with a goal of helping them avoid a relapse of criminal behavior once they are released, which benefits both the inmate and society as a whole.
