## RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF WORKER FREEDOM INCLUDING RIGHT TO WORK

Whereas, the Commonwealth of Virginia has honored its Right to Work law since 1947; and

Whereas, Right to Work laws ensure that Virginians have the dignity to make their own choice on whether or not to join or financially support a union at their place of employment; and

Whereas, maintaining the voluntary nature of union support in our Commonwealth ensures better relationships between employers, employees, and unions, which is one of the important factors in Virginia's successful economy; and

Whereas, Right to Work states have greater growth in real household consumption and higher cost of living adjusted per capita disposable income; and

Whereas, Right to Work states enjoy greater overall job growth including in the manufacturing center; and


Whereas, Right to Work states have lower tax burdens; and

Therefore, Be it resolved that the Shenandoah County Board of Supervisors hereby stand in strong support of the Commonwealth of Virginia's longstanding laws protecting worker freedom, including our Right to Work law, to continue preserving worker choice and economic opportunity in our county.
