Vaping. CBD oils. Marijuana legalization expansion with edibles/candy targeted at kids. These are but a few of the challenges in consumer protection today. The purpose of my email is, in particular, the brazen national advertising currently occurring in the CBD industry. Each morning on my commute to/from the office, I hear a plethora of advertisements touting the health benefits of CBD by companies like CB Distillery, Medmen and others. While the advertisements may not specifically say, "Our potion can cure your health problem," the implication is clear. I am the US Attorney in what may be the poorest district in the nation. Coal mining and poverty are as much a part of the landscape as the hills and hollers that comprise it. These are good people and good Americans that struggle paycheck to paycheck to pay their bills, keep their kids in school and stay in their homes.

Healthcare is a particular challenge for the citizens in my district. My immediate concern is that these fake assertions by fake health supplement companies will entice self-diagnosis and self-treatment for individuals with serious health conditions. I worry that a young mother with a diagnosis of breast cancer will choose CBD over the treatment advice of her medical professional. I worry that a father with shoulder pain may try to treat the pain with CBD oils rather than seeking the advice of a medical professional and that he may fail to diagnose a more serious health condition like a tumor on his spine. There are countless examples that are foreseeable.

I believe the fake advertising of the CBD industry is an issue for which we should be concerned.

If there is anything I or my district can do to assist your efforts, please let me know. I am always available for a quick call or discussion.

We appreciate your work on behalf of consumers.



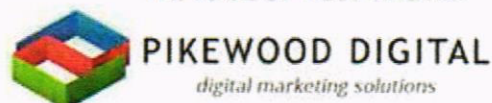

Per our conversation, we are offering everyone who was scheduled in the State HS tournament the opportunity to take advantage of ANY of our programming to use the remaining balance of the funds that were assigned to the tournament.

Joe,

Here are the Dry and Produced versions of the COVID-19 spot for Mike.

Quickly though, I need to explain the process I used to produce these because the reads are different on the Dry and Produced versions. First I took the unedited Dry Read that (b) sent me and it was 56ish seconds. Once I edited that down to a natural read with natural pauses, it was 52 seconds. I then took that 52 second file and stretched it out to 57 secs in one version and 59.5 secs in another. I used the 57 sec one in the Produced cut and the 59.5 for the Dry. The more length you stretch an audio clip, the more artifacts and distortion starts to happen.

I think the Produced version with the 57 sec edit sounds better because there are fewer artifacts in the audio so it sounds cleaner and the music fills out the extra 3 seconds needed. The Dry version would work since it's over 59 seconds, but you can definitely hear problems with audio quality due to the stretching.

My recommendation would either be use the Produced version or have him come back in to add another line or two to fill up more time.
