The margin of Pennsylvania voters who think the state government spends too much annually, suggesting voters have little appetite for excessive spending.

The percentage of Pennsylvania voters who favor limiting how much the state spends, including 81% of self-identified Republicans and 52% of self-identified independents (54% of registered Democrats make up a portion of key self-identified independents).

84%



The percentage of Pennsylvania voters who support putting a constitutional amendment on the ballot that would limit the annual growth of General Fund spending by the state.

The margin of Pennsylvania voters who support so-called "Taxpayer Protection Act" legislation that would limit annual increases in government spending.

The percentage of Pennsylvania voters who say they'd be "more likely" to vote for a candidate for state legislature who supports limiting the growth of state government, forcing lawmakers to focus on the core priorities of government.
