This is an interim response to Americans for Prosperity Foundation's Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), dated May 5, 2022. For this interim response, DHS reviewed 346 pages. 88 pages are being withheld in full and 50 pages are being withheld in part, pursuant to Exemptions 5 and 6 of the FOIA. 37 pages were reviewed and determined to be non-responsive, and 94 pages were determined to be duplicates. 77 pages require further consultation within DHS or with other government agencies.
