This is an interim response to Americans for Prosperity Foundation's Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), dated May 5, 2022. For this interim response, DHS reviewed 378 pages. 48 pages are being released in their entirety. 113 pages are being withheld in full and 115 pages are being withheld in part, pursuant to Exemptions 5, 6, and 7E of the FOIA. 41 pages were reviewed and determined to be non-responsive. 59 pages require further consultation within DHS or with other government agencies.
