
Survey Results

The AFP TN SD 28 Survey was conducted by IVR / Landline and Online Mobile Interviews from February 12 - February 17 among a random sample of 306 likely Republican Primary voters. The survey has a margin of error of +/- 5.6 percentage points. Results are weighted. Some percentages in crosstab reports for this poll may not add to 100% due to rounding.


Q1: Voter Registration

Q2 : Voter Likelihood


Thinking ahead to the August Republican Primary, how likely are you to vote? Would you say extremely likely, somewhat likely, or not very likely? Sample Size: 306


Q4 : Image Test







Q7 : School Choice Income Status


Should the school choice program being proposed be made available to all Tennessee tax-paying citizens, or only those who are of the lowest income? Sample Size: 306

Q8 : Parental Control of Tax Dollars




Are you more or less likely to vote for a candidate who supports this school choice proposal being promoted by Governor Lee? Sample Size: 306






