We, the undersigned, represent a coalition of grassroots organizations dedicated to promoting economic prosperity and opportunity for all Americans. We write to express our strong support for the 2017 Trump Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (TCJA) and to urge you to take immediate action to make its provisions permanent. The Trump TCJA has been instrumental in providing confidence and protecting prosperity for working-class Ohioans and businesses across the Buckeye State.

Three key provisions of the Trump TCJA that have significantly benefited our communities are:

- **Reduction in Individual Tax Rates:** The Trump TCJA lowered tax rates across the board, allowing Ohioans to keep more of their hard-earned money. This reduction has provided much-needed relief to middle-class families and has stimulated consumer spending and economic growth.
- **Expansion of the Standard Deduction:** By nearly doubling the standard deduction, the Trump TCJA simplified the tax filing process and increased the amount of income exempt from federal taxes. We believe that making the TCJA permanent will continue to provide stability and confidence for Ohio's working families and businesses. We urge you to act swiftly to ensure that these provisions remain in place for the long term.
